**Project Description:** This is a short description of the project, some detail of materials or technique may be listed here, but there is a separate section for more detail. (i.e. Jewelry box made from ebon and maple, inlaid with silver and agate stones in a Celtic cross pattern.)

All projects must be on site by Noon, January 23<sup>rd</sup> to be considered for awards.

Their Excellencies of Caer Galen and their chosen panel will perform judging at Caer Galen Arts and Sciences.

The Patronage Prize Committee, immediately following judging, will award cash prizes. Award scrolls will be sent after their completion by the Caer Galen Scribal Guild.
